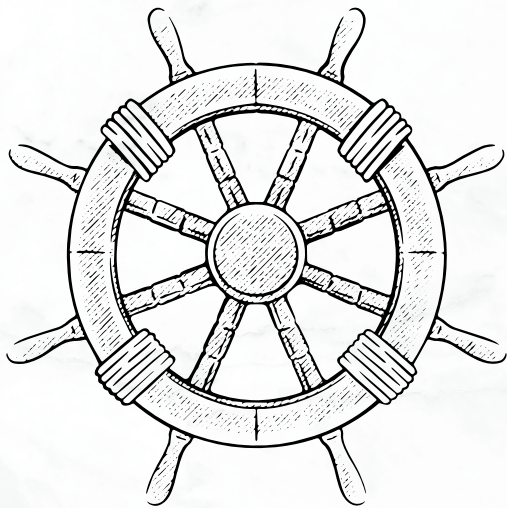
Faith Facts

- We can hold onto God's promise to lead and guide us in this life.



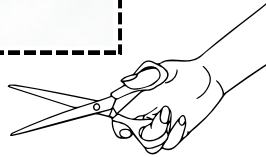

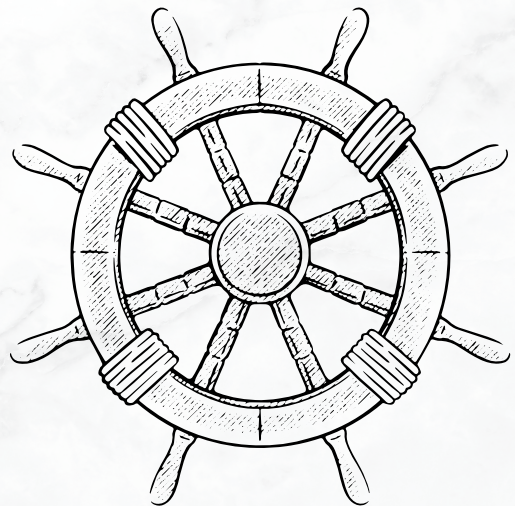
