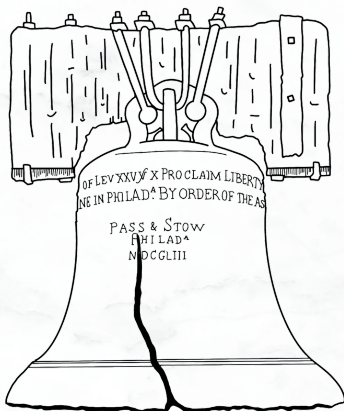
Faith Facts

- Throughout history and in current times, division has existed. Our faith offers peace in times of divisiveness, for we know God's plan is good.



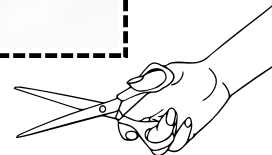

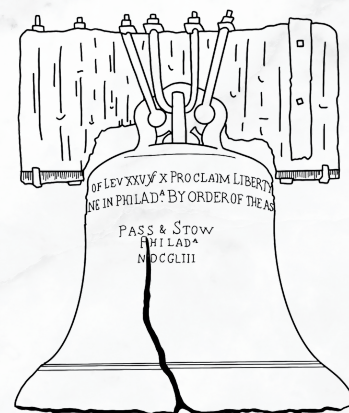

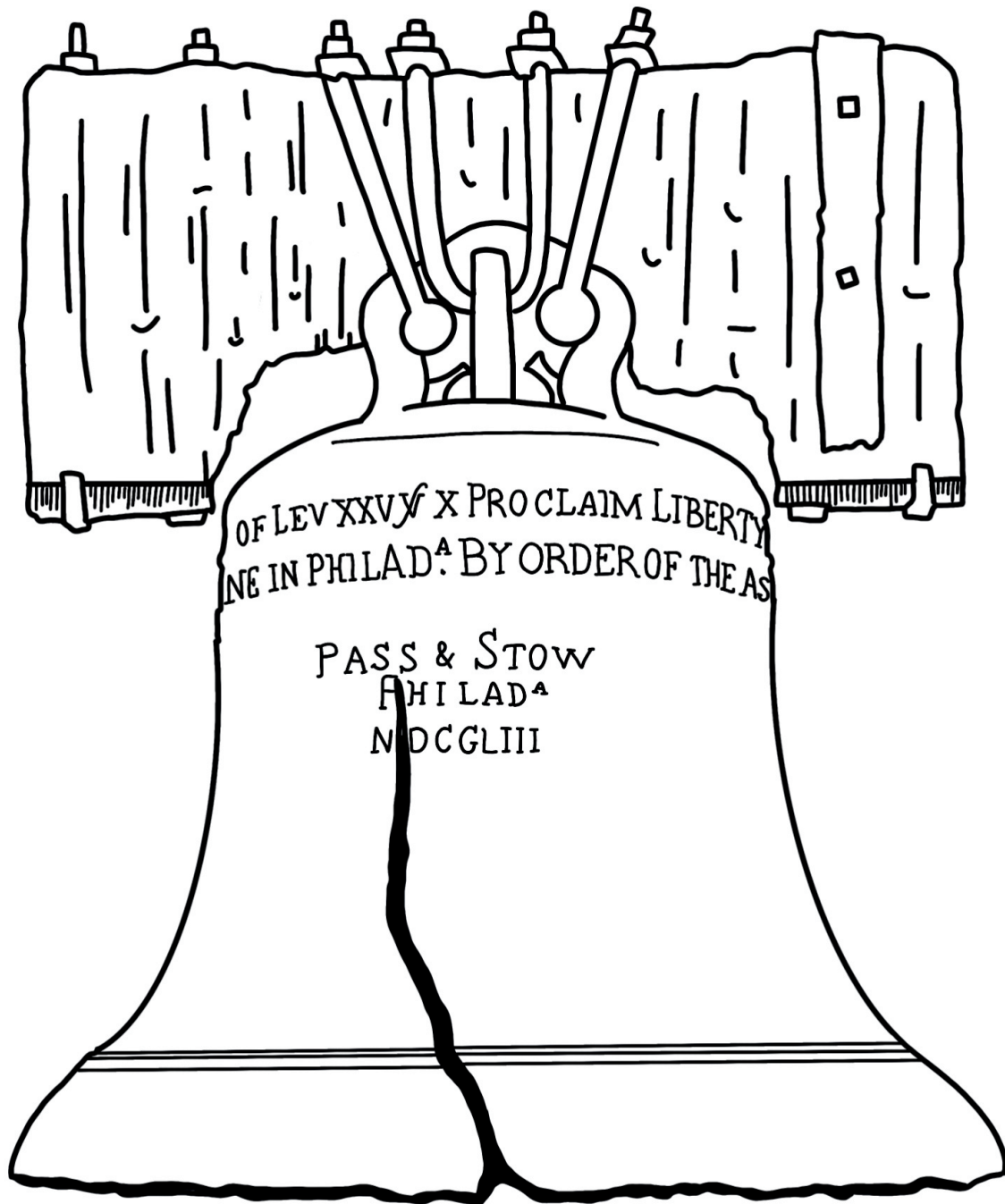
