- Jesus demonstrates the greatest act of love for us when he died on the cross for our sins.

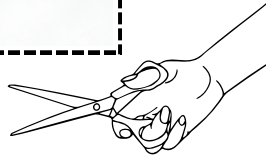


